Rules of Play for 50/50 Electronic Raffle:

1. The lottery will take place during Mohawk Millions event on Saturday, September 23, 2023 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.
2. All tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older.
3. Tickets are available in following amounts: 2 for \$5, 10 for \$10, and 75 for \$20.
4. Tickets will be available at all events held throughout the building at the Woodbine Mohawk Park– 9430 Guelph Line, Milton, ON.
5. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by Ascend Funding Solutions.
6. After buying, patrons will be given by the sellers, a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
7. The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw for that day/game.
8. The lottery will close and the winning ticket number will be selected at 9:30pm.
9. The amount of the 50/50 will be 50% of ticket sale proceeds.
10. The winning number will be announced via PA system at racetrack, on internal television screen systems at racetrack and published on website.
11. If the patron with the winning number on their ticket is at the event where the number has been drawn, they may then come to the main 50/50 booth within the racetrack or;
12. If the winner is not in attendance at the event, or does not wish to claim their prize immediately, they may claim their prize by contacting Milton District Hospital Foundation at: 905-878-2383 ext. 7173, or by email at: vbriguglio@haltonhealthcare.com. The ticket may then be brought to the Foundation office (725 Bronte Street, S., Milton, ON) at an agreed upon time for ticket verification. The winner will then be paid by cheque for the amount posted at the event for which they bought their ticket. Or; the winner may make arrangements to bring the winning ticket to any remaining event for verification and payment by cheque. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies. **All payments will be made by cheque.**
13. The winning ticket holder has **6 months** in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased for.
14. The winner must provide his/her name, address and phone number with picture identification for our report sheet.
15. Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that game. If

the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.

16. If no winner comes forward the number will be announced repeatedly over the PA system, and posted on the internal television screen systems at racetrack, published on website.

17. At subsequent events, the number will be posted at each selling station.

18. In the event that no winner comes forward, the winning stub will be kept in a safety deposit box and held for 6 months. After that time period has elapsed the prize will be donated to Milton District Hospital Foundation, with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).

19. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 draws: any staff or volunteers who are selling 50/50 tickets or involved in raffle at any length.
